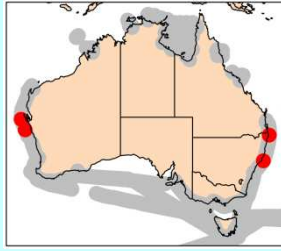


Monocorycaeus robustus

(Giesbrecht, 1891)



Phylum Arthropoda
Order Cyclopoida
Family Corycaeidae

Synonyms

Corycaeus robustus Giesbrecht, 1891

Size

Female: 2.00 – 2.40 mm

Genus notes

- 2 setae on antenna are of subequal length
- Female genital somite protrudes dorsally over the basis of the anal somite
- Caudal rami short and divergent
- One species in genus

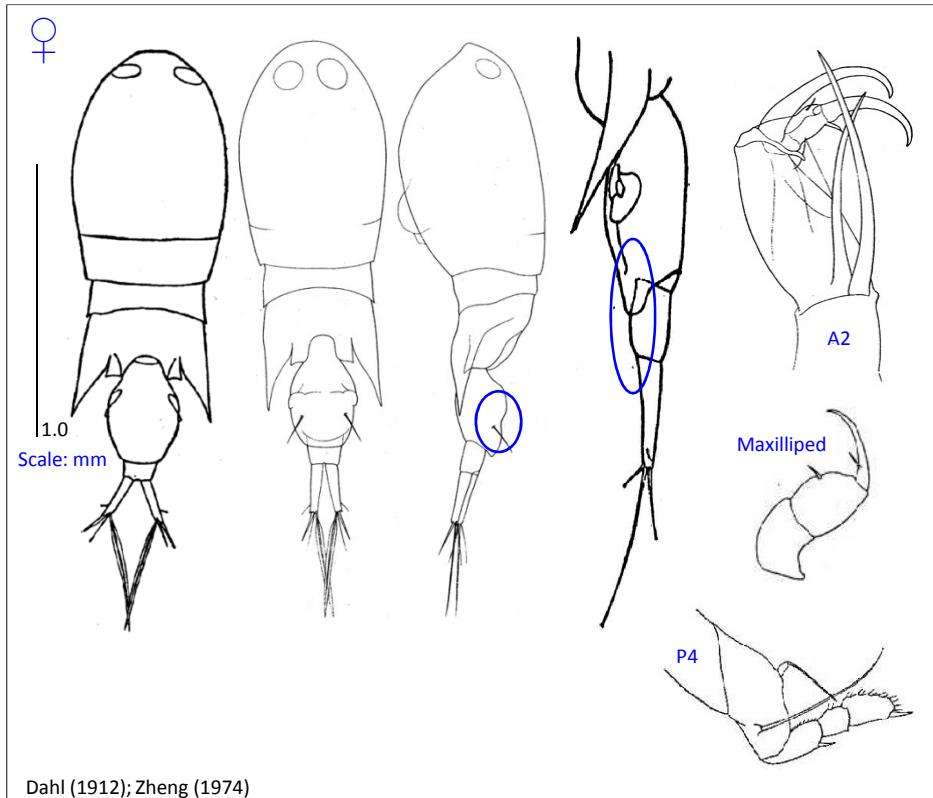
Female

- Large and robust
- Genital somite large and oval, 1.4 times as long as wide, tubuncle present on dorso lateral margin, posterior overlaps anal somite
- Anal somite very short
- Caudal rami 1.5x as long as anal somite and very divergent

Distribution

- Epipelagic
- Oceanic and coastal
- Atlantic and Pacific oceans

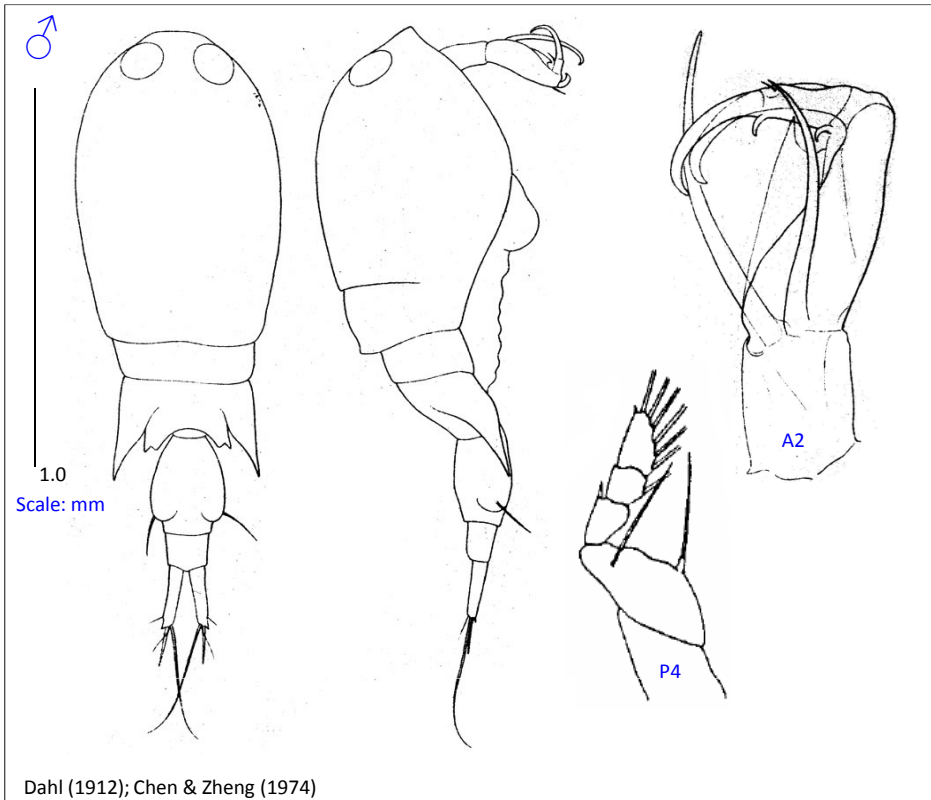

Size
Male: 1.60 – 1.95 mm

- Male**
- Genital somite large
 - Anal somite short
 - Caudal rami divergent and more than 2 times as long as anal somite
